




Housing Recycle



SEPTEMBER 2017 Recycle Monthly Average Pounds Per Home 73 Tons collected






Housing Trash to Landfill



SEPTEMBER 2017 Landfill Monthly Average Pounds Per Home 383 Tons collected






Housing Recycle/Trash Rate



SEPTEMBER 2017 Recycle - VS - Trash to Landfill Average Per Home










FY17 Housing Refuse
