



CASA of Bell and Coryell Counties Overview

- CASA (Court Appointed Special Advocates) of Bell and Coryell Counties is a **nonprofit organization** that provides **court-appointed volunteers** to advocate for children in foster care.

Why is CASA important

- **Over 1,000 children** are currently in foster care in Bell and Coryell Counties.
- Bell County has seen a **20% increase in child abuse** and neglect cases since 2013 and is continuously ranked as one of the **top counties for child abuse** in the state of Texas.

The CASA Impact

- **Children with a CASA have a 65% family reunification rate** compared to the state average of 30% without a CASA.
- **Children are more likely to find safe, permanent homes, receive needed educational and medical services, and experience fewer placement changes** when supported by a CASA advocate.


