The Bell County Public Health District is urging residents to take precautions when outdoors after six swimming pools, over the past six weeks, test positive for the West Nile Virus in Temple, Little River-Academy and Fort Cavazos.

The Mosquito Monitoring and Surveillance Program monitors 22 sites in Bell County from April to late November.

Symptoms of the West Nile Virus — which is most commonly spread through a bite from an infected mosquito and is not spread through coughing, sneezing, or touching other people or live animals — can include a fever, headache, body aches, skin rash and swollen lymph nodes.

Protect yourself and your loved ones by applying an insect repellant, treating your clothing and gear if outdoors or wear protective clothing, remove any standing water around your home.
