MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: School Year (SY) 2016-2017 Child and Youth Army Fee Policy Changes

1. Reference. FRAGO 01 to Execution Order 300-16, School Year 2016-2017 Army Child and Youth Fee Policy, dated 18 November 2016.
2. In accordance with the above reference changes are being made to the SY 2016-2017 Child and Youth Army Fee Policy. The implementation date for these changes will be 1 November 2017.
3. Mission levels have been replaced with five eligibility criteria:
 - a. Criteria 1. Deployed Contingency Operations.
 - b. Criteria 2. Assigned to a Warrior Transition Unit.
 - c. Criteria 3. Deployed Rotation Forces.
 - d. Criteria 4. Deployed Non-Contingency Operations.
 - e. Criteria 5. Survivor Outreach Services.
4. For a Soldier to be eligible for deployment support benefits, one of the above eligibility criteria must be indicated in either official orders or a letter from the commander. Temporary Duty, Temporary Change of Station and Permanent Change of Station statuses must align with one of the five eligibility criteria.
5. The following benefits will no longer be authorized for new deployment statuses effective 1 November 2017:
 - a. Five monthly hours of respite care for Rear Detachment Cadre.
 - b. Five monthly hours of respite care for Recruiters.
 - c. Category 1 fee reduction for surviving children and children of wounded warriors.
 - d. Sports and fitness reduction.
 - e. SKIES instructional programs fee reduction.

- f. Any fee reduction beyond the free 16 hours of respite care.
- 6. Patrons who are presently receiving deployment support benefits will continue to receive these benefits until their current deployment status changes. Those receiving the Category 1 fee reduction will continue to receive this reduction until their annual re-registration occurs.
