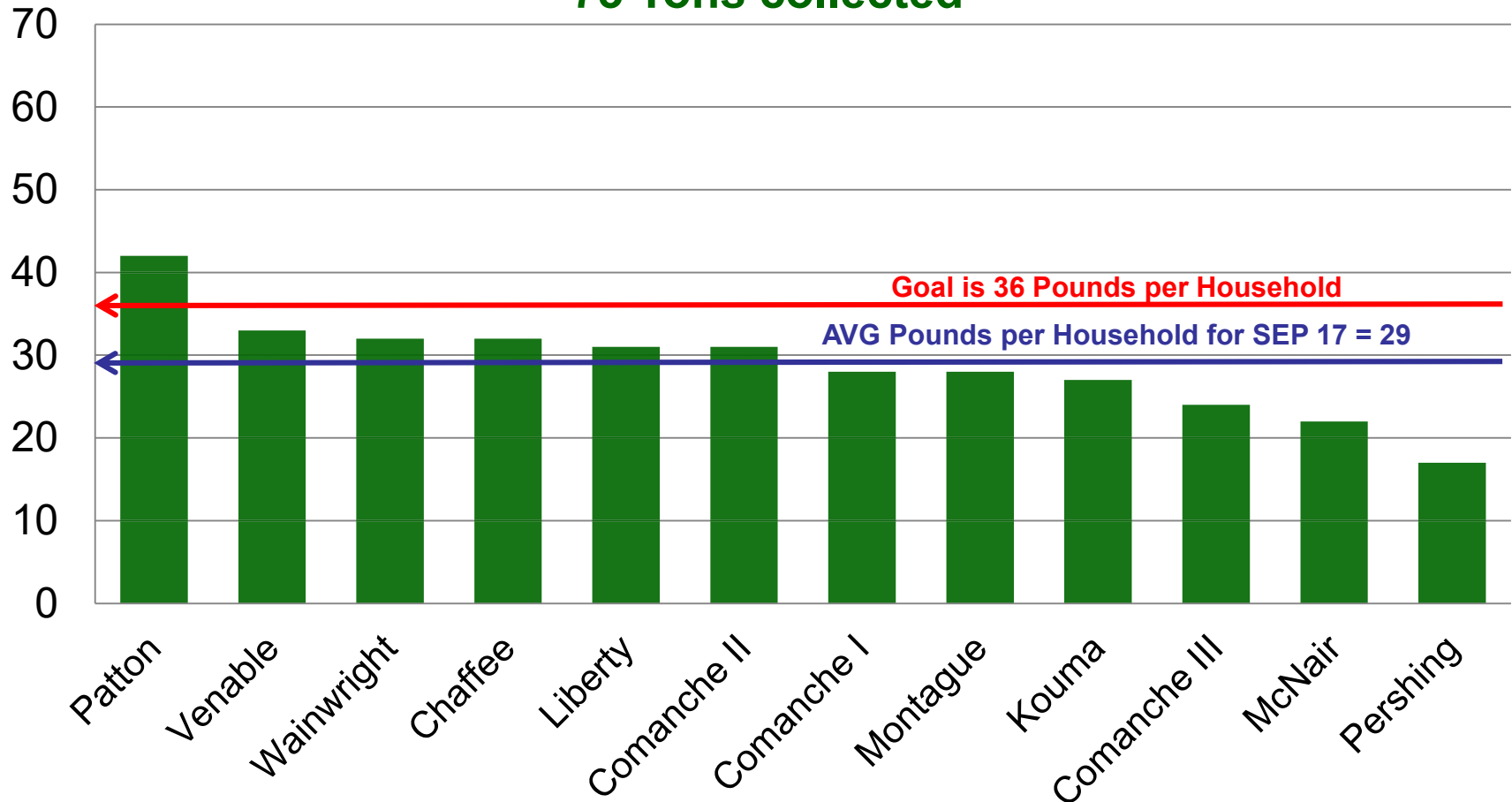

73 Tons collected

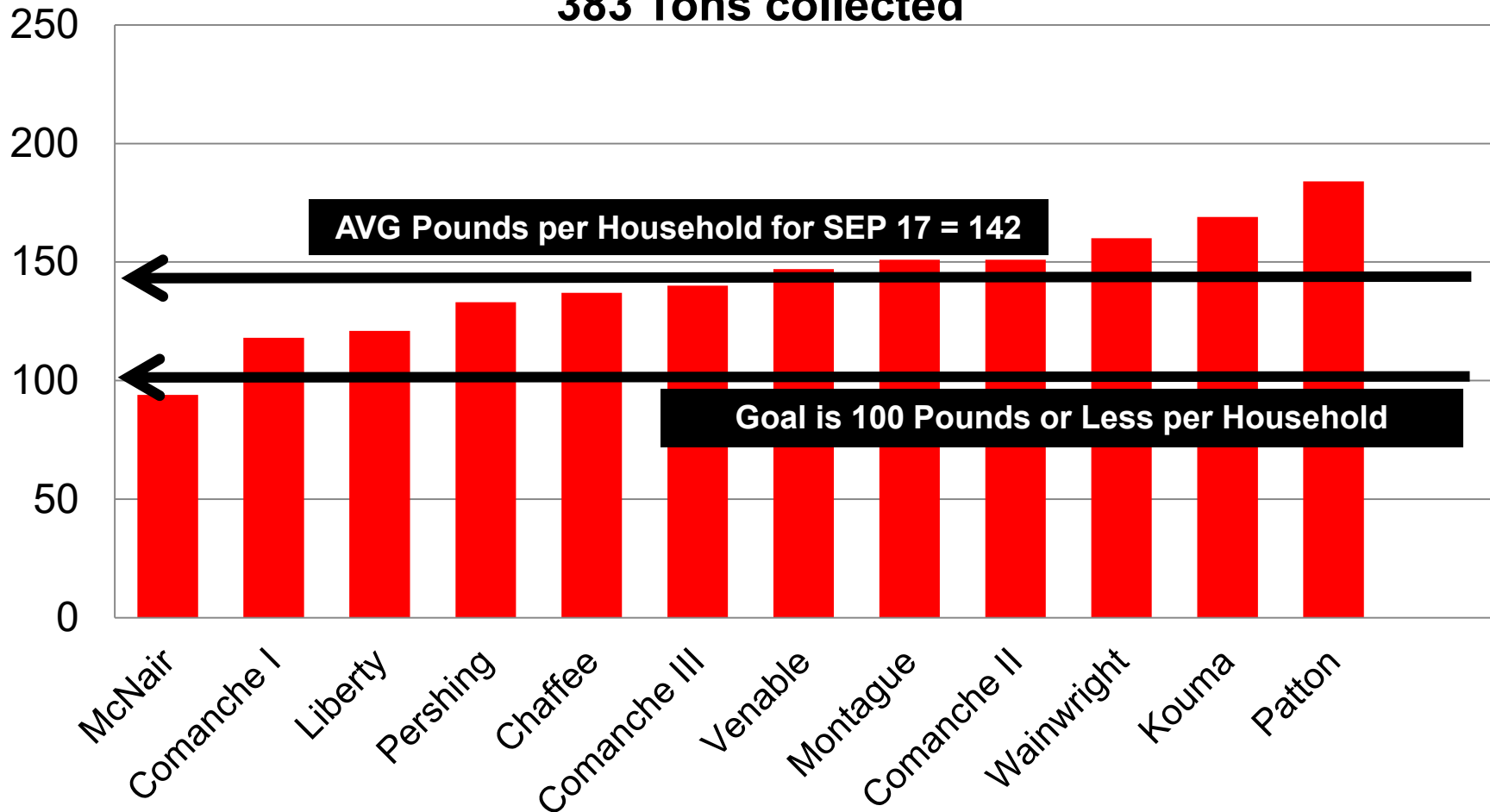




Housing Trash to Landfill



SEPTEMBER 2017 Landfill Monthly Average Pounds Per Home 383 Tons collected



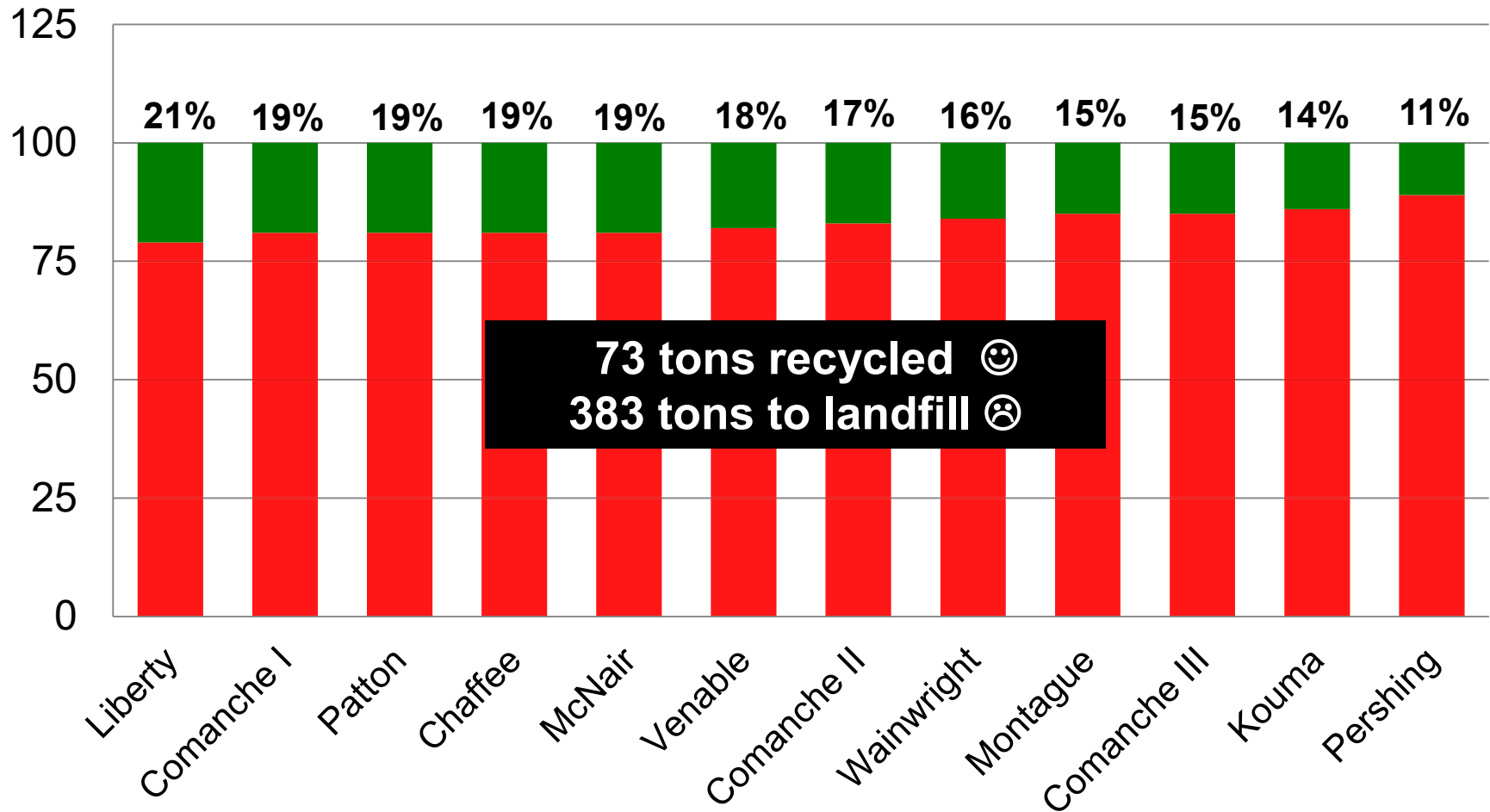


Housing Recycle/Trash Rate

Recycle - VS - Trash to Landfill Average Per Home



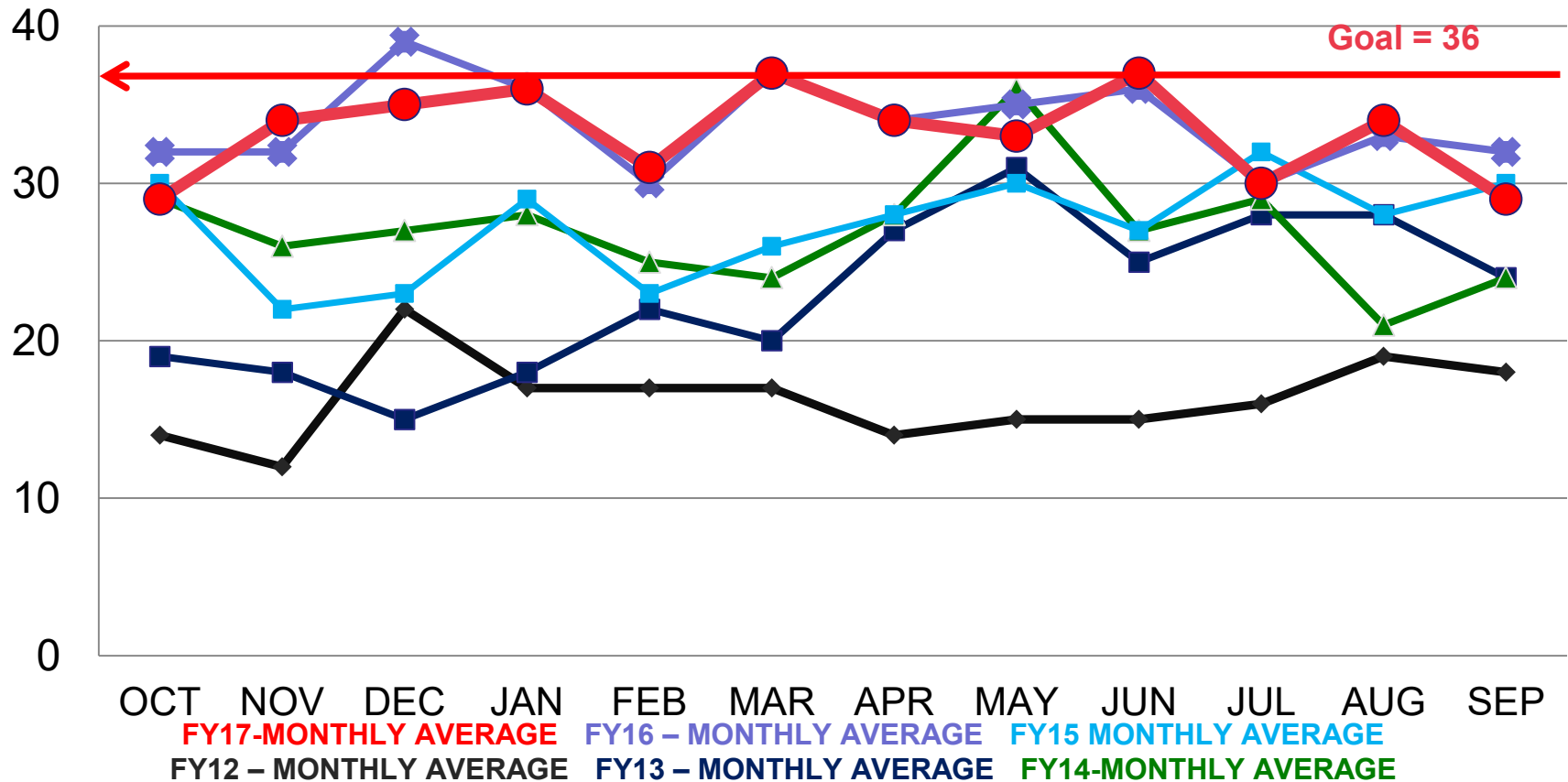

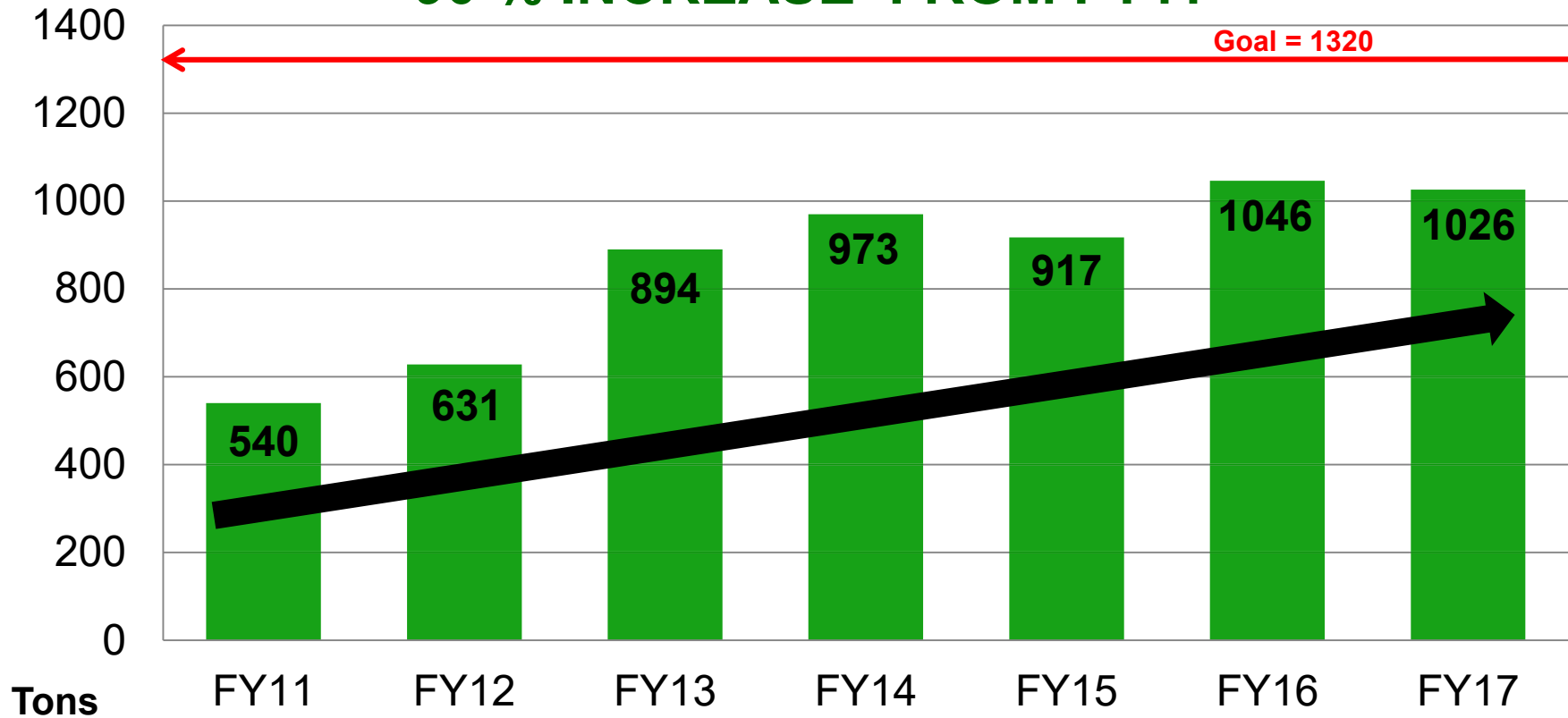

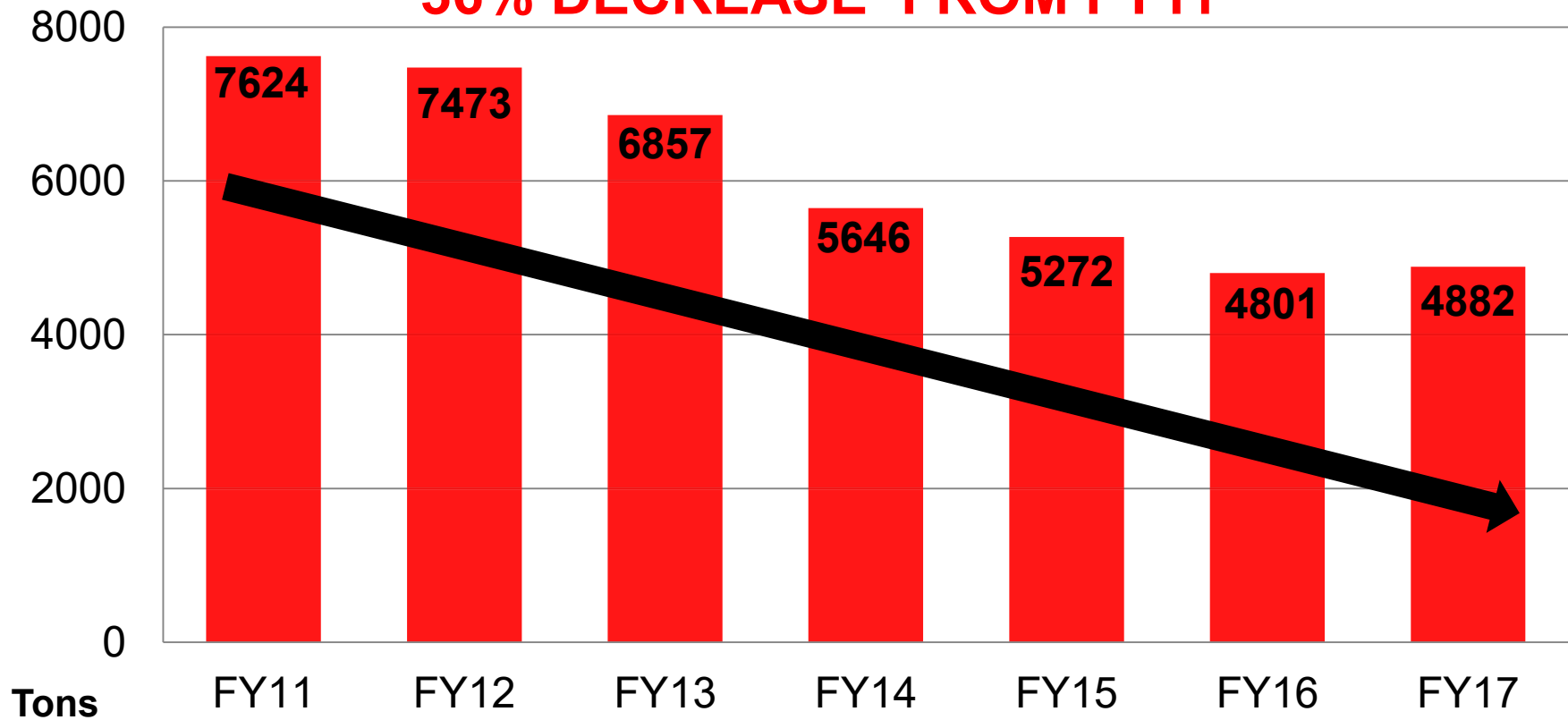
