Police Presence

- The DES will provide an increased police presence in all Fort Hood Housing areas on Halloween Night from 6:00 pm – 8:00 pm.
- The increased security presence will include a total of 35 police officers during this timeframe (an increase of 15 police officers above the normal patrol plan)
- Police patrols will include both mounted and dismounted



Fire Safety

- Choose costumes, wigs, and props that are flame resistant/retardant.
- Avoid candles, if at all possible, and tell children to stay away from open flames including jack-o-lanterns with candles in them.
- Remember keep exits clear of decorations, so nothing blocks escape routes.
- Did you know that decorations are the first thing to ignite in 900 reported home fires each year. Two of every five of these fires were started by a candle.

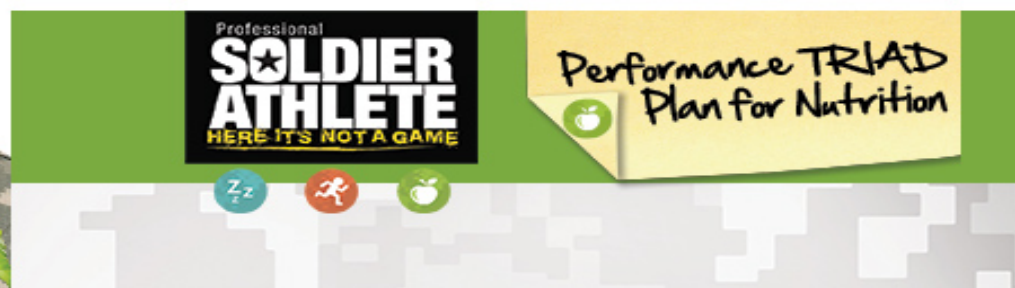
