New TRICARE Benefit: Urgent Care

Effective January 1, 2018

Non Active-Duty TRICARE Prime enrollees (i.e. Active-Duty Family Members, Retirees and Retiree Family Members) can **receive care for urgent care needs** at a **TRICARE authorized facility without a referral from their Primary Care Manager**. Urgent medical conditions are those that are not life-threatening, but require attention within 24 hours.

Urgent care conditions include, but are not limited to:

- muscle sprains/strains
- cuts
- fever
- flu
- vomiting
- diarrhea
- sore throat
- coughs
- eye irritations
- ear pain
- rashes
- urinary tract infections

- **STRONG STAR (South Texas Research Organization Network Guiding Studies on Trauma And Resilience)**
- **CAP (Consortium to Alleviate PTSD)**
- **The nation's largest DoD-funded research consortia**
 - **Focused on the development and evaluation of the most effective approaches possible for the treatment of combat-related PTSD and comorbid disorders (TBI, sleep disorders, suicide, chronic pain, substance use disorders)**
- **Headquartered at the University of Texas Health Science Center at San Antonio with a large research cell (approximately 30 clinical research faculty and staff) embedded within Carl R. Darnall Army Medical Center**
- **Recently completed 5 of the DoD's largest randomized clinical trials**

Project Remission: Maximizing Outcomes with Intensive Treatments for Combat-Related PTSD

- Extends results of recently completed clinical trial at Fort Hood**
- Goal is to treat PTSD into remission so Soldiers can be fully fit for duty**

 - Primary foundation of treatment is Prolonged Exposure (PE) therapy**
 - No other treatment has more scientific support for its effectiveness**

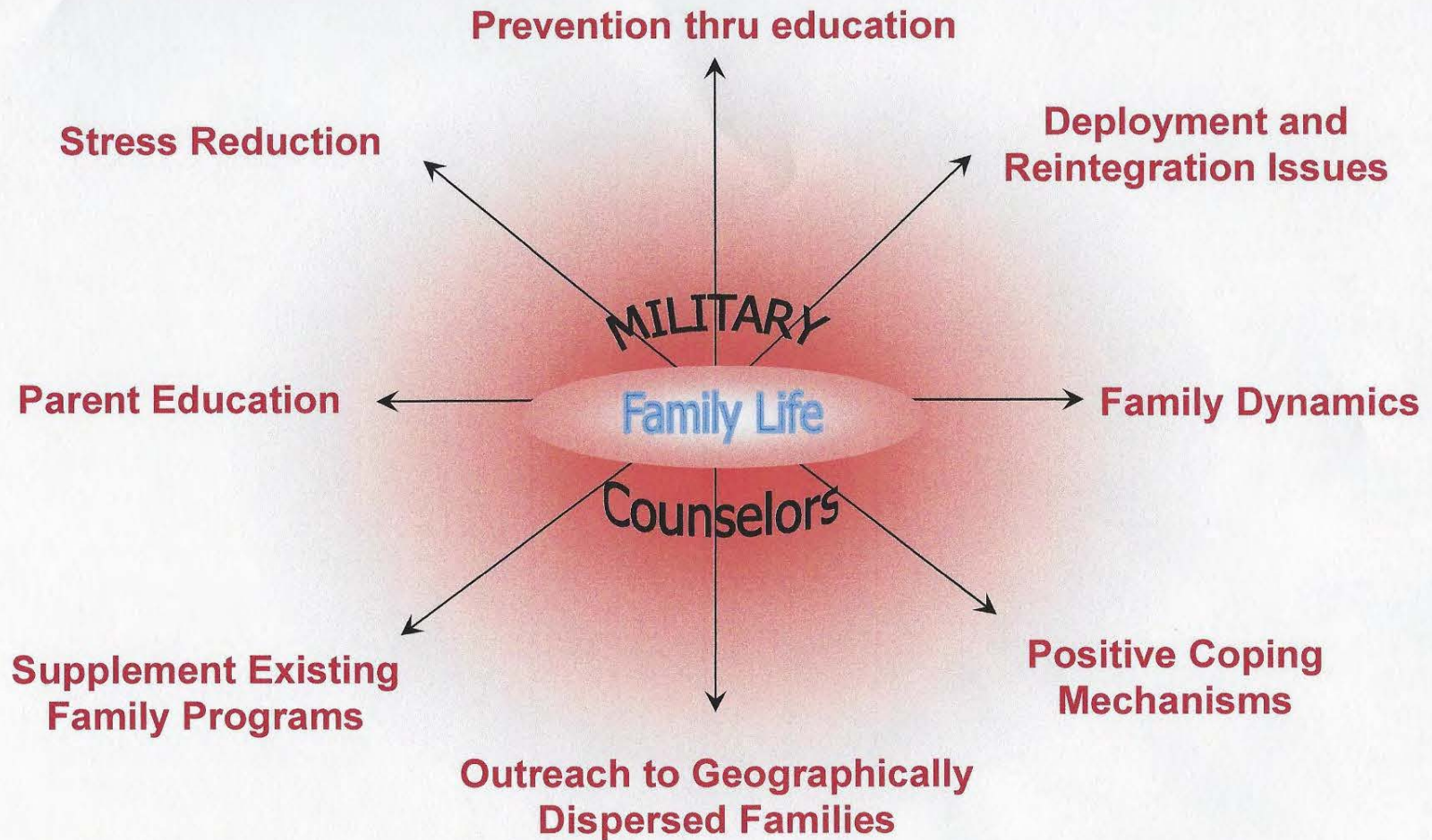

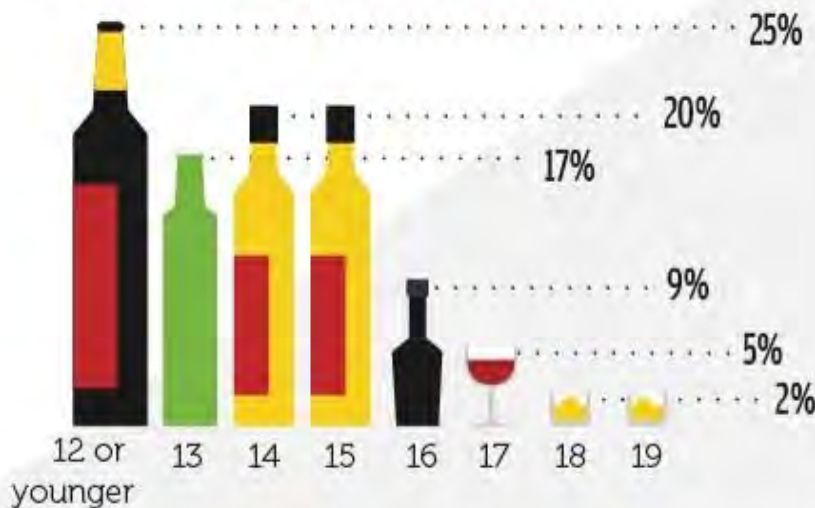
