BACK TO SCHOOL

It's Back to School Time!! The Fort Hood School Liaison Officers (SLOs) are excited and ready to support welcoming students back for the 2021-2022 school year. We are experts in assisting and updating parents on any educational or academic needs for the Fort Hood area. The SLO's can share information, resources and any support you may need to ensure your students have a successful and positive school year.

We can aid military families with finding answers and solutions regarding questions about schools in the area. The SLOs work with the nine school districts surrounding Fort Hood, including Killeen, Copperas Cove, Belton, Lampasas, Florence, Gatesville, Temple, Salado and Jarrell Independent School Districts.

It is important to reassure our students that learning is ongoing and essential especially during this time. The last school year was unprecedented and full of unexpected changes. The experience taught us to adapt and develop new skills in learning. We developed an appreciation of our resiliency skills and became stronger because of it.

Although the new school year may have some changes, our resiliency skills and the knowledge that we are stronger will support us.

The SLO office assists military families by supporting a seamless transition into our local school districts. Our support programs such as Youth Sponsorship, provided through the Child & Youth Services (CYS) Youth Centers, allows transitioning students to connect with a local teen having similar interests and hobbies. In addition, each Youth Center schedules exciting educational events and activities monthly. Please refer to this booklet and your area Youth Center location for more information.

The SLO office assists the area Home School Families with information and support resources for their needs. Our partnerships and connections with organizations and resources in the area provide innovative learning opportunities. We send out a monthly email to share area opportunities and activities. If you would like to be included on our email list, please come by our office to complete an email form. We also sponsor a Resource Fair twice a year to ensure Home School Families are familiar with the resources available on Fort Hood and the surrounding communities. The fall Home School Resource Fair will be held at Bronco Youth Center on Friday, 8 Oct 2021 from 1:00 p.m. – 4:00 p.m.

Killeen ISD provides PreK-3 and PreK-4 programs at the on post schools and these programs are available to students who meet the eligibility requirements.

School enrollment for Pre K through 12th grade will take place at your child's zoned school or on the schools website.

REGISTRATION

Child and Youth Services (CYS) exists to serve Families. To access CYS, Families must first register with CYS.

Parent Central Services

Bldg 36000 Darnall Loop. 254-287-8029

Hours of operation are Monday through Friday from 7:30 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. Virtual registrations through CYS Services Online are highly encouraged. In support of COVID-19, adjusted operations with walk-in registrations welcome until 3:30 p.m. daily.

Patrons are welcome during normal office hours for payments, enrollments, assistance requesting child care and updating wait list information through MilitaryChildCare.com and other registration/enrollment related services.

Eligibility

Patrons eligible for CYS include Active Duty Military, DoD Civilians paid from both appropriated funds (APF) and non-appropriated funds (NAF), Reservists on Active Duty or during inactive duty personnel training, those acting *in loco parentis* for the dependent child of an otherwise eligible patron, eligible employees of DoD contractors, Gold Star spouses and other eligible patrons on a space-available basis. In the case of unmarried, legally separated parents with joint custody, children are eligible for child care only when they reside with the military service member or eligible civilian sponsor at least 25 percent of the time in a month that a child receives child care through an Army program.

Note: *In an in loco parentis relationship, a person takes on the role of a lawful parent by assuming the obligations and discharging the duties of a parent without formally becoming an adoptive parent or legal guardian. The child(ren) must reside with and be supported by the person. A special power of attorney to act in loco parentis is required to be on file.*

Requirements for Registration

Children In Grade 5 And Younger:

1. Military/Civilian ID Card
2. Current shot record (must be up-to-date at the time of registration; not required for children in School Age Care if enrolled in a public school)
3. Health assessment (30 day grace period is given to those registering with Fort Hood CYS for the first time; a sports physical is required for all children prior to participating in Youth Sports & Fitness activities)
4. Two local emergency release designees

Complete the following forms:

1. DD Form 2652 – Application for DoD Child Care Fees (current household income verification will be required in order to determine the Fee Category for full time care, part time care, before/after school care, and camps.)
2. Health Screening Tool
3. Medical Action Plans and/or Special Diet Statement, if applicable

Youth 6th grade and older:

1. Military/Civilian ID Card
2. Teen Registration Packet
3. Health Screening Tool, Medical Action Plans and/or Special Diet Statement, if applicable

Multidisciplinary Inclusion

Action Team (MIAT):

Children/youth that require an accommodation while in care may require a MIAT review; All Medical Action Plan forms and Special Diet Statements must be completed by a health care provider and are available for download at hoodarmymwr.com. The MIAT process requires approximately 14 business days for processing. Patrons seeking to complete an annual registration renewal are urged to turn in the required medical forms at least three weeks in advance to Parent Central Services.

School Liaison Services Child & Youth Services School Liaison Officers (SLOs) work with, and help support, nine surrounding school districts in the Fort Hood area. These include Belton, Copperas Cove, Florence, Gatesville, Jarrell, Killeen, Lampasas, Salado, and Temple.

Are you concerned about your child's education and ensuring a smooth transition for each PCS? Then Go to the SLOs! The CYS SLOs are the Army's designated "point person," responsible for serving as the liaison between Families, local school districts and various other community partners in education to promote quality education and academic support for military children and youth. The SLOs provide information on the education process and assist parents in maneuvering through the school system. While CYS SLOs are not advocates, they are here to inform and link military Families to the individual, group, or other resource that can hopefully address and resolve the issue. The SLOs provide necessary tools to empower parents to be advocates for their children's education.

Army-Wide School Support Initiatives

Provide direction for educational support, assistance, and transitions.



School Liaison Officers (SLOs) assist with transitions associated with military life and facilitate communication among schools, parents and installation leaders

Facilitate understanding of the **Interstate Compact on Educational Opportunity for Military Children** and liaise between the parent and the school as needed to ensure compliance and develop solutions

Provide information about **post-secondary opportunities** from college and vocation school applications to scholarships and career choice

Provide **parent and educator workshops** on a variety of transition issues

Youth Sponsorship facilitates transition from installation to installation and school to school by providing information, a sense of belonging and the opportunity to make friends in both youth centers and schools


Deliver the **Army Ready and Resilient** program for teens aligned, through experiential and outreach activities, with the training Soldiers and Army Spouses receive, creating a common language around resilience between parents, youth and educators



Facilitate the **Adopt-A-School** program fostering relationships between units and local schools and encouraging parent involvement

Through **In/Out Processing Protocol**, provide Soldiers with children an overview of available CYS options and educational support

Army High School Senior Stabilization supports college and career readiness by allowing Soldiers to delay PCS so students can complete their senior year of high school

Child Development Services (CDS)



Child Development Centers (CDC)

Offer full-day and before/after care for children enrolled in pre-kindergarten in on-post elementary schools, and hourly care programs for children 6 weeks – pre-kindergarten age. A developmentally appropriate curriculum for young children is planned by the teaching staff with attention to the different needs, interests, and developmental levels of each child.

Hourly Care Services

** Temporarily Suspended*

Hourly Care Services are available at Meadows and Montague Child Development Centers. Hourly care is short-term child care, no more than 20 hours per week, for children whose parents have a medical/dental appointment, volunteer commitment, or just need some respite time. Reservations may be made up to 30 days in advance.

All CDCs offer trained teaching staff, balanced meals, age-appropriate developmental activities and all eligible CDCs are nationally accredited.

PROGRAMS AWAIT TO BE EXPLORED

Family Child Care (FCC)

The Family Child Care program is a professionally managed network of adult individuals certified to provide child care in on-post government quarters for children 4 weeks to 12 years of age and provide programs such as extended hours [for parents who must go on temporary duty (TDY) or field assignments] or special needs care. FCC homes may also offer hourly care services, part-day care, or before and after school care. FCC providers are certified after meeting basic regulatory requirements and their homes are regularly monitored by FCC staff and inspected for fire, health and safety compliance. In addition, FCC providers work to obtain National Association for Family Child Care (NAFCC) accreditation using the same level of standards as CDCs and are encouraged to participate in special activities. Kids On-Site (KOS)

Provides on-site child care for children 6 weeks to 12 years in approved on post facilities. Call us to make arrangements for your next Family Readiness Group meeting, social event, retreat or other gathering: 254-287-7273.

YOUTH & SCHOOL AGE CARE

School Age Care (SAC)

The SAC program offers before and/or after school care for youths in grades K-5 that attend school on Fort Hood. Full day programs are offered during school-out days, but all sites are closed on Federal Holidays. Hourly care is also offered for grades K-5. Students are afforded the opportunity to engage in many activities and programs like 4-H, student elections, and more. Programs offer opportunities for children to engage in technology, arts & crafts, digital arts festivals, building blocks, robotics, field trips, and more! All activities and events are age-appropriate.

Youth Centers (YC)

The youth centers are open to all Middle and High School teens. Services are available at Bronco Youth Center, High Chaparral Youth Center, Montague Youth Center, and Comanche Youth Center. Youth Centers are open Monday-Friday after school to 8 pm, 12-8pm when school is out but all sites are closed on Federal Holidays. Teen programs include activities, events, and projects that are age appropriate. Each center offers a computer lab, leadership opportunities, special interests clubs, Teen Sponsorship, Educational Assistance, fitness/workout areas and many fun trips youth are eligible to sign-up for. Need a ride to the youth center? Look no further. Students enrolled in Killeen ISD or Copperas Cove ISD have the advantage of riding the CYS "TEEN TAXI" which is an after school pick-up service that will transport youth to designated Fort Hood Youth Centers.



Youth Sports and Fitness

Bring out the athlete in you with Youth Sport and Fitness! Team and individual sports programs, along with special camps and clinics, are offered year round for youth ages 3-18 years. All Sports programs are recreational based, focusing on teaching youth the fundamentals of various sports in a fun environment! All activities and events are open to the beginner athletes as well as the most seasoned player so there is something for everyone. Come out and be part of a great team with Youth Sports and Fitness!

Instructional Programs

Instructional Programs consists of classes designed to complement & support the experiences children & youth have in Army CYS and in schools. They teach children discipline, problem solving, decision making, conflict resolution, game rules and social etiquette as well as subject matter content. Students will increase their knowledge, be inspired, explore new activities and acquire new skills.

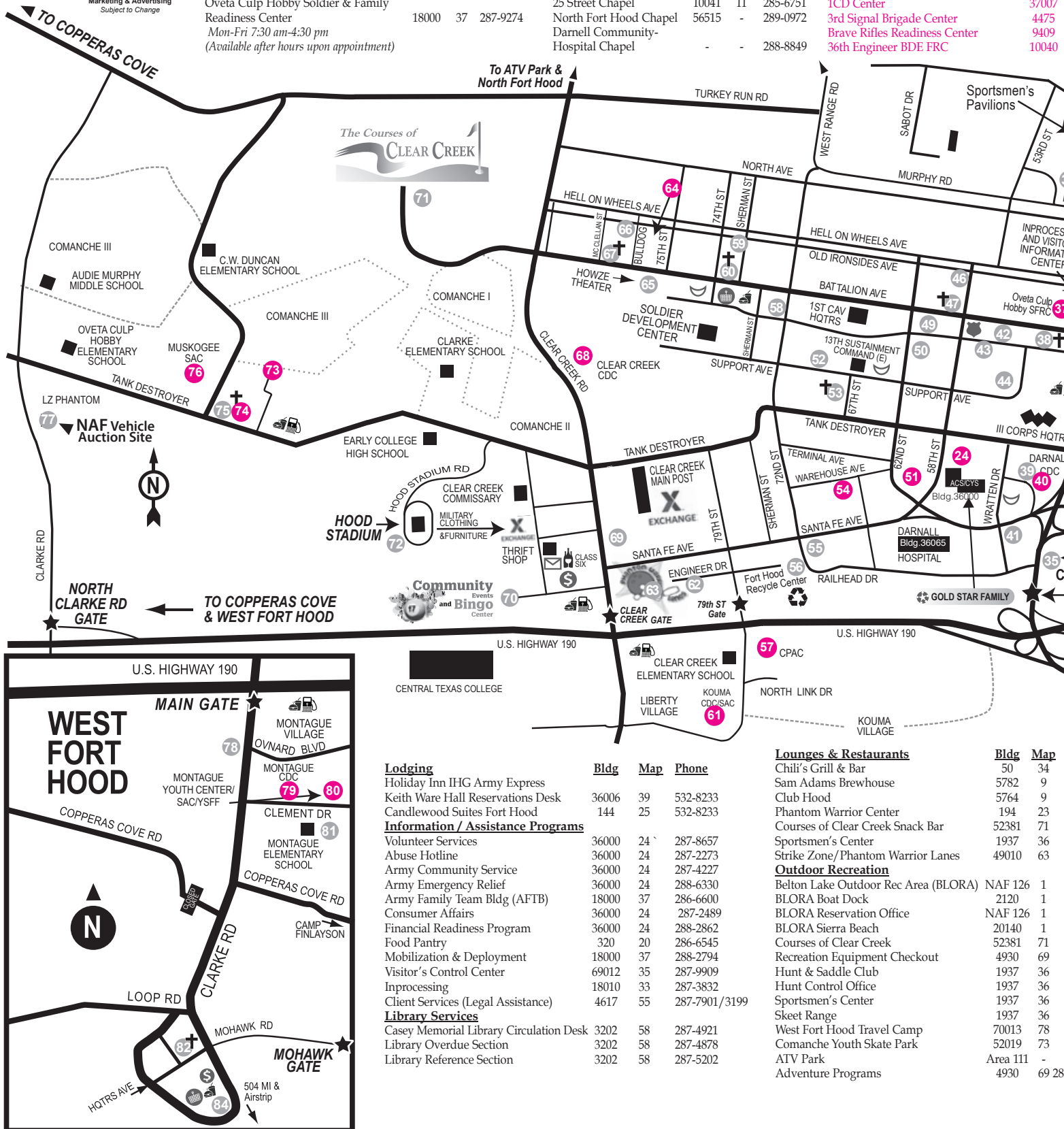

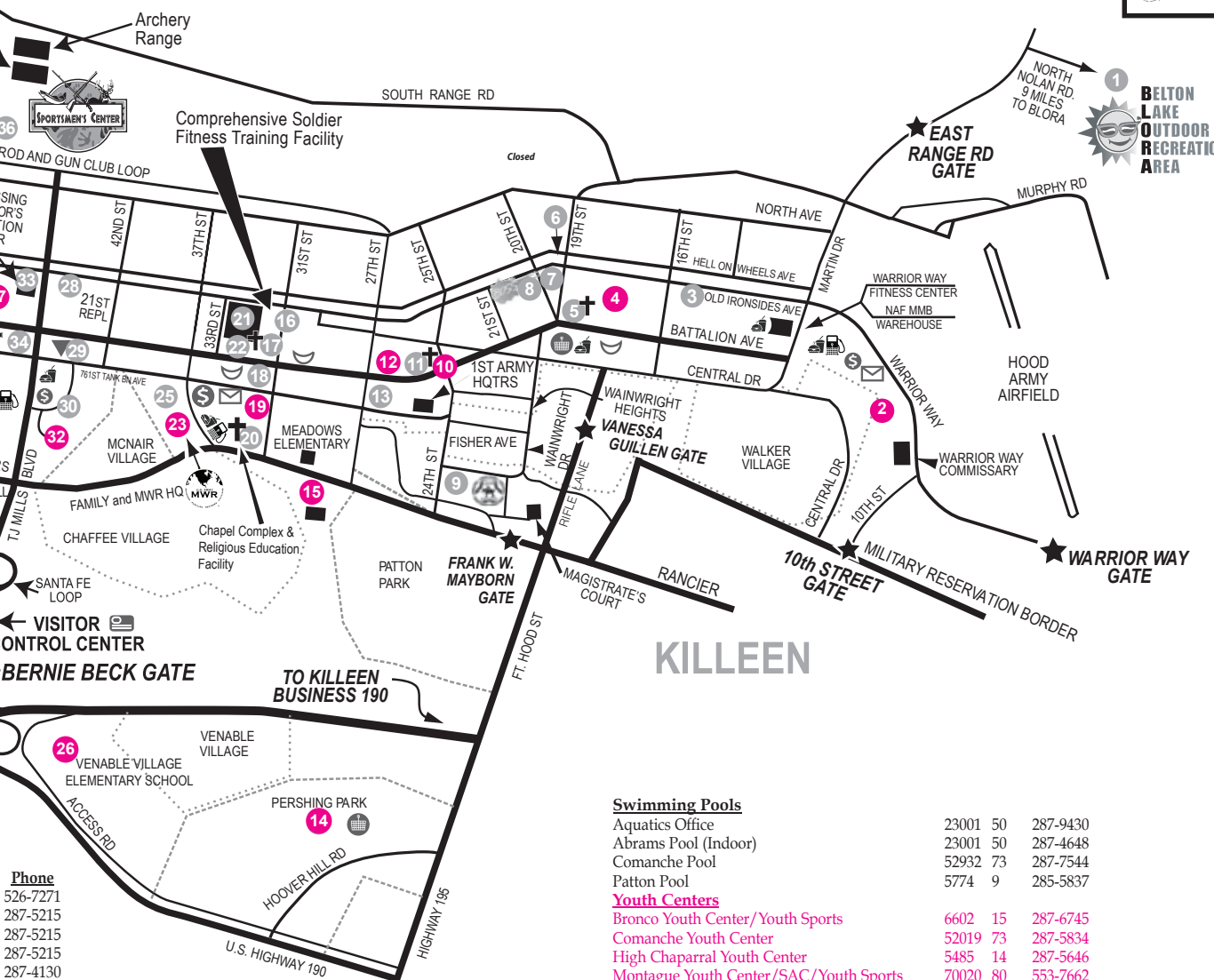

CYS Deployment Benefits

Don't miss out. Check it out!



In order to be eligible for CYS Deployment Support Services, one of the below eligibility criteria must be indicated in either official orders or a letter from the Commander. TDY, TCS and PCS statuses must align with one of the five (5) eligibility criteria. Length of deployment must also be indicated on orders or Commander letter, if applicable.

CRITERIA 1: DEPLOYED CONTINGENCY OPERATIONS

* 180 days or longer:

- **Mandatory Deployment Briefing Hourly Care** - Free Hourly Care or Kids On Site (KOS) Care during mandatory deployment briefings
- **Respite Hourly Care #1** - 16 hours of Free Hourly Respite Child Care (per child per month), *(starting 30 days before deployment and ending 90 days after return from deployment)*
- **Fee Reduction** – 20% reduction to fees for regularly scheduled Full-Day or Part Day Care, *(starting 30 days prior to deployment and ending 90 days after return from deployment)*

* 90 - 179 days:

- **Mandatory Deployment Briefing Hourly Care** - Free Hourly Care or Kids On Site (KOS) Care during mandatory deployment briefings
