



Each of our network partners goes through a comprehensive vetting and validation process to ensure the highest standards of service delivery are met. We stand ready to partner with state's Department of Veteran Services to advance the delivery of solutions to the military and veteran community.

WHERE DO WE SERVE?

Combined Arms has 650 vetted and validated network organizations on the platform, 63 of which are national, enabling CA to serve all major social service categories in all 50 states and 2 US territories. In addition, CA has the following partnerships:

When a Client makes a connection with a specific service, that organization is contacted directly by the Combined Arms network.




After the Client has worked with the organization, feedback, and outcomes are gathered. The Client can request more services at any time.






