

2025 Joint Emergency Medicine Exercise (JEMX)

WHAT IS COMBINED ARMS?

Combined Arms (CA) is the nation's most effective and efficient closed-loop referral network of local, state, and federal agencies. We provide veterans and military families with a seamless and user-friendly digital marketplace experience for accessing social services. Each of our network partners goes through a comprehensive vetting and validation process to ensure the highest standards of service delivery are met. We stand ready to partner with state's Department of Veteran Services to advance the delivery of solutions to the military and veteran community.

WHERE DO WE SERVE?

Combined Arms has 650 vetted and validated network organizations on the platform, 63 of which are national, enabling CA to serve all major social service categories in all 50 states and 2 US territories. In addition, CA has the following partnerships:

- Selected by the White House Challenge to End Hunger and Build Healthy Communities based on collective work in social determinants of health, specifically food insecurity
- Statewide contracts with Veterans Affairs agencies to serve as the single solution for all of Texas, Virginia, and South Carolina


