- One life lost to suicide is too many. When we connect to protect, we build relationships and a community that enhances resilience and protects against suicide.
 - Members of the military community often face emotional or psychological concerns from the stress of military life.
 - The Department of Defense strives to eliminate barriers to care service members face when seeking mental health support.
 - Service members are entitled to request help confidentially.
 - Seeking care early can help address mental health challenges before they worsen and prevent a crisis.





WHAT IS IMPACT AID?

Supporting Schools that Serve Federal Lands

Impact Aid is a federal program established in 1950.

It provides funding to school districts that lose local tax revenue due to the presence of:

- Military bases
- Native American Lands
- Federal Housing
- Other Federally Owned Property





Impact Aid

WHY IS IT NEEDED?

Filling the Funding Gap

Public schools are partially funded through local property tax.

Federal land is exempt from property taxes.

These districts face revenue loss but still provide education for local students.

- Funded through the U.S. Department of Education.
- Annual application required with detailed student counts.
 - Survey of KISD students required by USDE for application to support student counts submitted
 - Survey date for 2025-26 school year has not been finalized. Anticipate late September to early October.
 - Will publicize survey availability via social media, website, and campus communications
- · Amount varies based on:
 - Number of federally connected students
 - Type of federal property
 - Congressional appropriations
