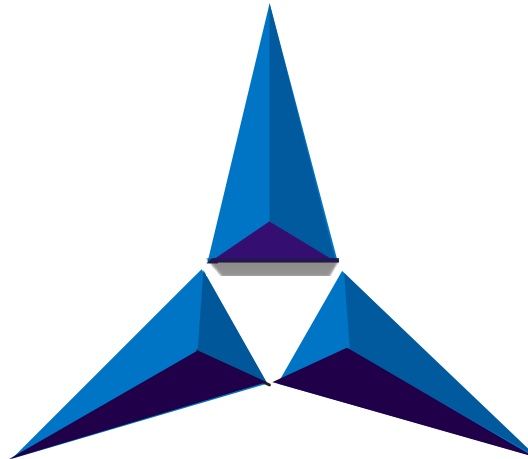

BLUE CARD UPDATES

TOPIC 1: Oktoberfest was a missed opportunity

EXPLANATION/DISCUSSION: There were not enough food trucks or bar space. Long lines, not enough seats, etc.

PROPOSED RECOMMENDATION: Make it a Ft. Hood Craft Beer Fest w/more food trucks and invite local craft brewers from Central TX.

RESPONSE: F&MWR makes every effort to provide quality events to Fort Hood Soldiers, Civilians, Retires, and Family members.

This year Oktoberfest was moved to the Phantom Warrior Center to enhance the customer's experience, approximately 4500 people attended, surpassing last Oktoberfest by 1500 participants. The Phantom Warrior Center hosted seating for 500 customers, four beer lines in two locations, and two food concessions.

Outside four food trucks were scheduled to participate, although two back out last minute. The F&MWR team continues efforts to improve our event planning and execution to meet our customer expectations. As always, customer feedback is welcome.

TOPIC 2: Food Handlers Course

TOPIC 3: Youth Sports Parent Meetings

EXPLANATION/DISCUSSION: Parents have to attend a Youth Sports Meeting for every season. The information is duplicitous.

PROPOSED RECOMMENDATION: Make it a yearly requirement and note seasonal/requirements.

RESPONSE: Youth Sports and Fitness hosts a Parent Meeting for every season to ensure all information for the current sport is provided to the patrons. Topics discussed at the Parent Meetings include practice/games locations, safety requirements, uniform issue procedures, Parent Code of Ethics, sports physicals, and the Youth Sports Program Agreement.

The Youth Sports Program Agreement is an annual requirement and updated each fiscal year.

Email reminders for the Parent Meetings are sent to patrons enrolled in the current sports season. Within the email reminder, parents are provided with the contact information for both Youth Sports offices if there are any questions or concerns. Youth Sports and Fitness contact information is also on all receipts for the program.

The Youth Sports program staff are available Monday-Friday from 0830-1730 to assist patrons if they are unable to attend the Parent Meeting.

DPW has provided limited assistance.

PROPOSED RECOMMENDATION: Extreme focus on elimination of rats/ will remove vectors but need installation assistance with a deliberate elimination of those pest.

RESPONSE: DPW does recognize the issue with rodents within the 1st CAV footprint, and is working with the unit leaders, Occupational Health, DPW Environmental, and Service Contractor to eradicate the rodents. DPW's SGM has engaged unit senior NCOs to identify house cleaning and self-help efforts that will help in eliminating rodents within the facilities.


