





## **COMMUNITY SERVICES COUNCIL MEETING – January 29, 2020 BLUE CARD UPDATES**

**TOPIC 1:** Motor pool secondary containment and hazmat mitigation

**EXPLANATION/DISCUSSION:** Is there a way forward to assist units to install secondary containment and environmental compliance systems to help mitigate hazmat/environmental issues?

**PROPOSED RECOMMENDATION:** Install permanent secondary containment systems specifically for waste disposal and M979/M969 fuel systems. Improves the overall safety for soldiers and future inspections.

**RESPONSE:** Permanent secondary containment systems for fuel tankers are not included in the Army's standard motor pool design, and they are not currently required on Fort Hood as long as the tanker is not being used to dispense fuel. However, if any unit wishes to purchase and use portable secondary containment systems, that is perfectly acceptable as long as they are maintained and kept clean. If any unit has a specific reason why they would need a permanent, concrete drive-in secondary containment area in their motor pool, they can contact DPW to discuss the matter or submit a form 4283 work request describing their requirements. DPW thanks you for the question and suggestion, and hope you will discuss this or any other issue further with your unit's Environmental Compliance Assistance Team (ECAT) representative, or stop by the Environmental office (Building 4622) anytime.
