
FACT OR MYTH?

Victims will immediately ask for help or assistance and will self-identify as a victim of a crime.

- Trafficking is the same as smuggling.
- Trafficked persons can only be foreign nationals or are only immigrants from other countries.
- Trafficking must involve some form of travel, transportation, or movement across state or national borders.
- There must be elements of physical restraint, physical force, or physical bondage when identifying a human trafficking situation.



Worldwide, nearly 24.9 million people are victims of human trafficking in 2016... bringing in profits of over 150 billion dollars (ILO).












Child Sex Trafficking





WHAT ARE THE RED FLAGS?

- Scripted answers
- Inconsistencies in story
- Branding or tattoos, especially that reflect ownership or money
- Bruising with varied stages of healing with black, purple, blue, yellow shades
- Cigarette burns, rope burns, scars, cuts or other physical abuse
- Travels to other cities frequently
- Uses terms common to the sex industry
- Appears helpless, shame, malnourished
- Inability or fear of making eye contact
- Chronic runaway; homeless youth
- Dating much older, abusive, or controlling men
- Not attending school or numerous absences
- Sudden change in attire, possessions, behavior.

Approach the victim?

In most cases, NO. Call appropriate agency to report. If an emergency, call 9-1-1 and say you suspect trafficking and need immediate assistance.

Ask why they don't leave?

"Why" questions can seem judgemental. Just listen and use words such as "tell me more about..."

Try to rescue the victim?

NO...this could endanger the victim AND YOU. Report to the proper agency.

WHAT CAN YOU DO?

Learn to RECOGNIZE, RESPOND, REFER, and REPORT to local law enforcement and the National Human Trafficking Hotline.

- PARTNER with other local entities that are working in this area.
- SUPPORT alternative programs that will keep children out of juvenile detention centers and provide much-needed services.
- CONTACT policy makers to encourage them to recognize children as victims and prohibit prosecution of children who are victims of sex trafficking.
- **ENCOURAGE trauma-informed care.**

REMEMBER that this is a problem that is not isolated to girls and to which there is no single solution.

SHARE what you have learned with someone else and/or SCHEDULE a future training.
