
# **Blue Card Updates**

**TOPIC 1: Gym Space on the East of Installation** 

**EXPLANATION/DISCUSSION:** Is there a way forward to expand Burs/Starker gym or make a bigger one for units. Currently Starker Gym unit capacity almost every morning due to weather and 1<sup>st</sup> Cav Aviation, 3CR and 69 ADA.

**PROPOSED RECOMMENDATION:** Utilize a bigger space like the dominos area for new gym, it's better for parking as well. Just a suggestion.

**RESPONSE:** We recently awarded the construction of the locker room inside the Warrior Way Gym. When the locker room is complete the facility may be used for physical fitness training.



**TOPIC 2: Parking Lot Repavement** 

**EXPLANATION/DISCUSSION:** The 67<sup>th</sup> and 62<sup>nd</sup> street parking lot used by HHBN, 1CD BN staff and 2BCT, 1CD is still closed. Parking lot pavers have not been back to the parking lot in months.

**PROPOSED RECOMMENDATION:** The parking lot needs to be finished.

**RESPONSE:** With the exception of a small area requiring additional asphalt this parking lot is open for use.

#### **TOPIC 3: Road Construction**

**EXPLANATION/DISCUSSION:** I understand the need to improve the roadways and the result is great. But is it possible to incorporate weekend and/or evening paving. This would allow completion on time especially since weather delays happened during the week, but often the weekends are nice weather.

**PROPOSED RECOMMENDATION:** Pave weekends to complete on time and with minimal traffic.

**RESPONSE:** Weekend work schedules are utilized on select roadway projects at Ft Hood; however, weekend work does increase the overall cost of the project. It is a consideration on most projects but it's not always a viable option due to budget/funding constraints.






