**Did you know?** Texas Law requires a prescription for Pharmacists to administer vaccine to children under 7.  
\* Before you go, contact your child's PCM for instructions on obtaining a prescription.



When you get a flu vaccine from a participating network pharmacy, follow Command guidance for recording the vaccine in your shot record. You will need the date given, vaccine name, manufacturer, and lot number. Healthcare workers and ADPM will need to provide documentation of vaccine to their units medical POC for documentation into MEDPROS.

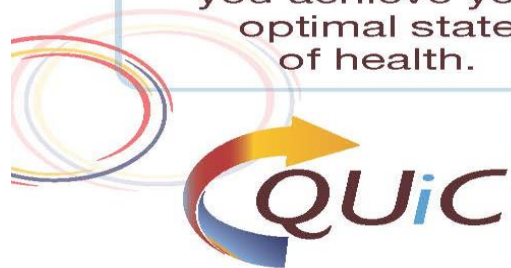

CH2A 2018 U.S. LONELINESS INDEX

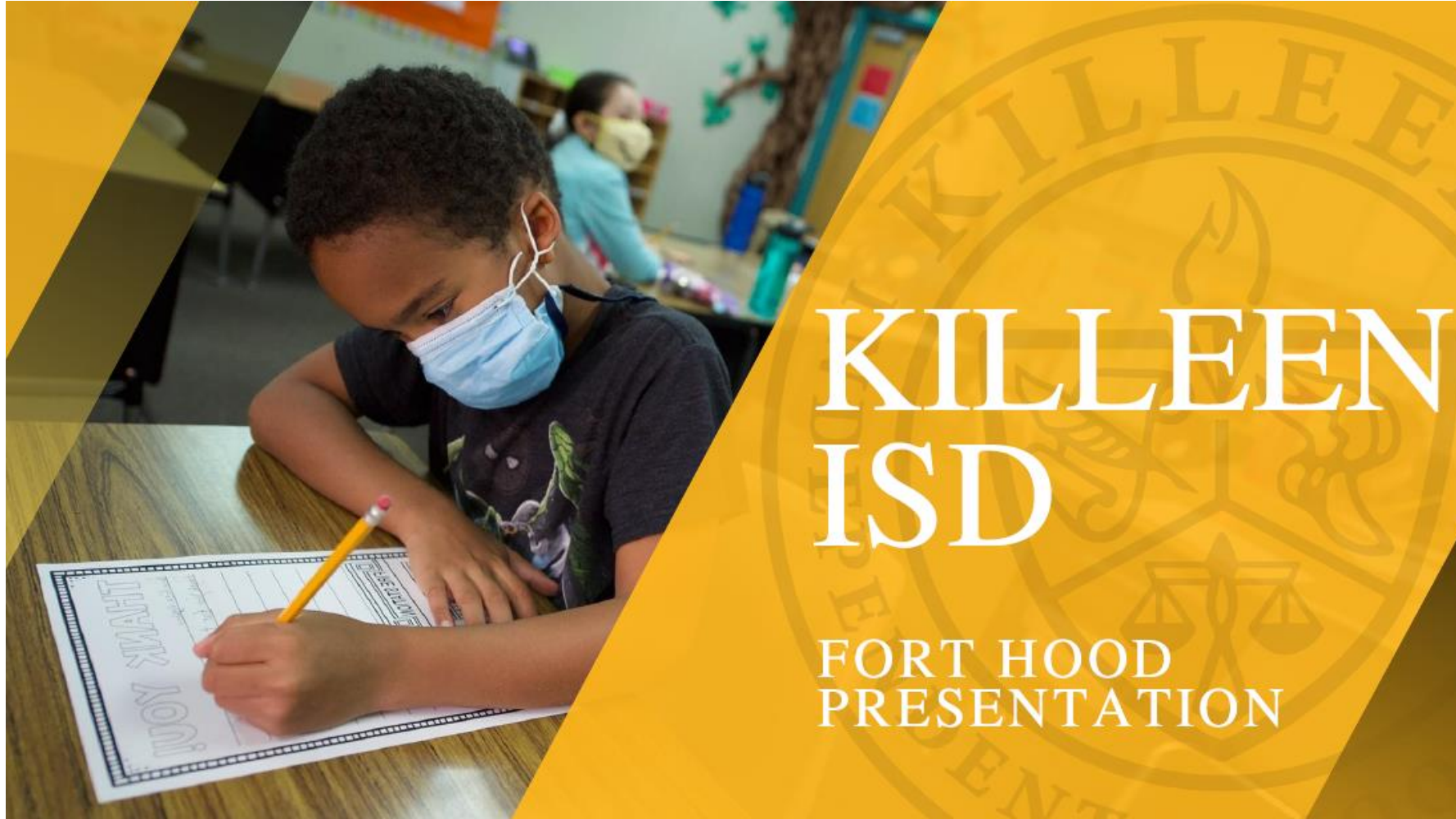

#### IN-PERSON

- Students are encouraged to bring their district-issued or personal device to school to complete work through Seesaw/Schoology. A device is NOT required.

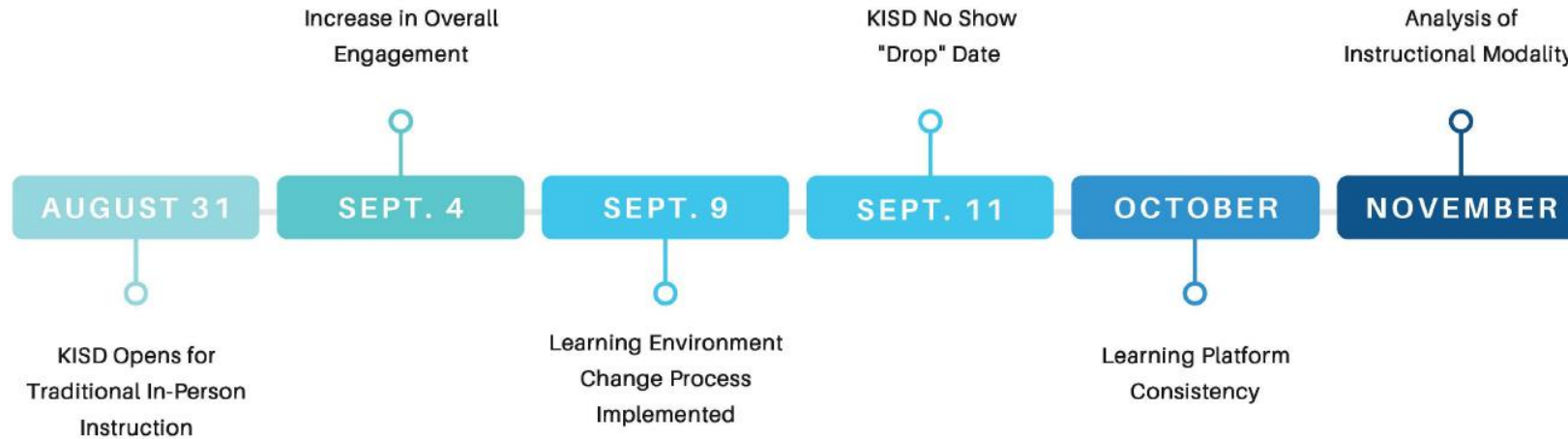

## COMMUNITY UPDATES

### Home-Based Business (HBB)

- ✓ **What is a Home-Based Business (HBB)? HBBs are Non-Federal Entities (NFE) owned or operated by authorized residents on Army installations who offer sales or services from within their own home with the express consent of the senior commander or designated authority.**
- ✓ **Residents in USAG-FH family housing who exclusively work remotely out of their residence (such as a teleworker), or who operate their own business exclusively through online means (for example, eBay and Etsy) are not considered HBBs, and do not require approval to operate.**







## COMMUNITY UPDATES

### To become a registered approved HBB

- ✓ To operate a HBB in Government-owned, leased quarters, or in privatized Army family housing, the HBB requestor can retrieve all current applicable guidance, procedures and application from the HBB link on the Fort Hood FMWR website at <https://hood.armymwr.com>.
- ✓ Once completed, the HBB requestor must submit the completed HBB application, all supporting documentation, and a copy of her/his valid DoD Military ID to the HBB Single Point of Entry (SPE). The SPE is located at DFMWR - NAF Support Services (NAFSS) Division, Financial Management Branch (FMB) in the Phantom Warrior Center, Building 194, 37<sup>th</sup> Street, Room 114, Fort Hood.

## COMMUNITY UPDATES

### Department of Defense Changes to Priorities for Child Care

- Effective 1 September 2020, DoD updated the priorities for child care to ensure priority access to child care for military members
- **Priority 1A** - Child Development Program (CDP) Staff
- **Priority 1B** - Single/Dual Active Duty Members, Single/Dual Guard/Reserve on Active Duty or Training Status, Active Duty with Full-time Working Spouses, and Guard/ Reserve on Active Duty or training status with full-time working spouses
- **Priority 1C** - Active Duty with part-time working spouses or spouses seeking employment and Guard/Reserve on Active Duty or training status with a part-time working spouses or spouses seeking employment
- **Priority 1D** - Active Duty with spouses enrolled full time in post-secondary institutions, or Guard/ Reserve on Active Duty or training status with spouses enrolled full time in post-secondary institutions
- **Priority 2** - DoD Civilians, single/dual or with full time working spouse
- **Priority 3** - Space Available - Active Duty with non-working spouses, DoD Civilians with spouses seeking employment, DoD Civilians with spouses enrolled in full time post-secondary education programs, Gold Star spouses, DoD Contractors, other eligible patrons





## COMMUNITY UPDATES

### Department of Defense Changes to Priorities for Child Care

- Families with current child care enrollment will receive a 45 day notice when there are those in higher priorities with an Anticipated Placement Time (APT) that exceeds 45 days beyond the Date Care Needed, as indicated in MilitaryChildCare.com.
- Priority 1C may be supplanted by Priorities 1A or 1B
- Priority 1D may be supplanted by Priorities 1A, 1B or 1C
- Priority may be supplanted by Priorities 1A or 1B
- Priority 3 may be supplanted by Priorities 1 or 2
