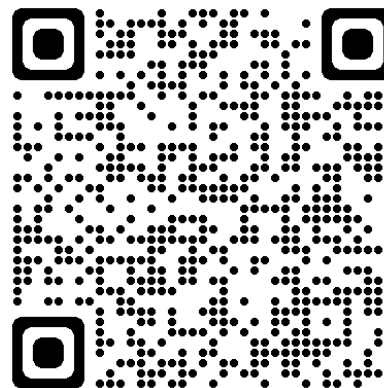

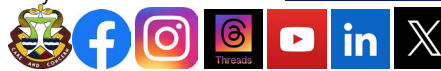

3 POINTS ON DRINK SAFETY

- Date rape drugs like Rohypnol, GHB, and Ketamine can be slipped into drinks without you knowing.
- Sudden dizziness, nausea, confusion, blurred vision, or memory loss can be red flags. Trust your instincts.
- If something feels wrong, get help right away. Move to a safe space and call or text 911.

3 PIECES OF ADVICE ON HOW TO PROTECT

- Never leave your drink unattended. Don't accept drinks from strangers and always keep it in sight.
- Go out with friends and look out for each other. Check in, speak up, and never leave someone alone or behind.
- You have the right to say "no" to anything that makes you uncomfortable. Trust yourself and remove yourself if needed.

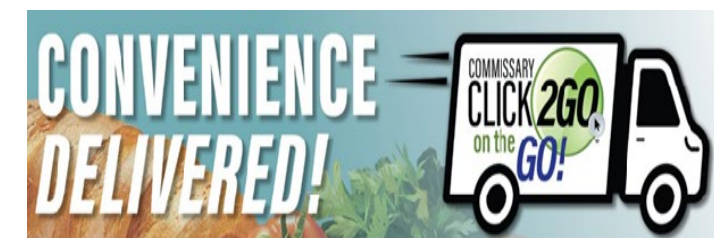
