

BASIC SKILLS EDUCATION PROGRAM (BSEP)

- Formal program of study designed to improve basic math, reading, and communication skills needed to raise the GT score.
- 1,086 Soldiers (E1-E7) enrolled in BSEP during FY22.
- For FY22 Q2, GT scores improved by an average of 15 points (pre GT score average: 92, post GT score average: 111).

- Soldiers need to take the TABE test before enrolling in BSEP (offered every Tuesday at 0900 and 1300).
- Four weeks of instruction for three hours a day, five classes are held per term.
- We recently held our first BSEP graduation ceremony with 74 Soldiers eligible for graduation.
- SSG Anthony Walker received the highest GT score last term with a 141 and made the biggest improvement to his GT score raising it by 40 points!
